## Anna Obletiloff Moore

Anna Obletiloff Moore, "Obie", of Prairie Village, Kan., passed away October 11, 2007, at her home. She was born on May 7, 1922, in Medvedie, Czechoslovakia. Anna moved to this country with her parents, brother and twin sister, entering Ellis Island in 1928. She graduated from Nanticoke High School in Pennsylvania. She earned her RN degree in 1944 from St. Joseph's School of Nursing, Patterson, N.J. Anna volunteered for active duty in the U.S. Army Air Core in 1944, attaining the rank of Captain in the USAF. She married Max R. Moore October 3, 1954, and became a lifelong resident of the Kansas City area. Anna spent her life raising her children and enjoying her granddaughters. She was active in her church, Tri Psi, American Dental Association Auxiliary, and The Society of Retired Air Force Nurses.
